The initial judging has been made and the consensus is that the village looks magnificent. A few of the highlights in May are listed below:-

Litter picks continue with support from School, Brownies and a broad cross section of the community.

The pupils at Haughton Primary School have produced a record 120 posters for BKV competition and these are displayed on Newport Road opposite the church. Olympic values are also depicted on posters at Village Hall to mark the Olympic Flame event. A Wildflower Garden project is also to be launched in addition to the involvement in the flower bed outside school.
